Direction (1-5): In each of the questions given below, a sentence is given with a few words highlighted. These words may or may not be placed correctly in the sentence. Identify the words which have been placed incorrectly and need to be interchange with other highlighted words to mark.

1. The idea that the (A) federalism of Article370 (B) weakened the Indian Union is (C)contrary and is (D) erroneous to a basicunder standing of democracy and lessons learnt from the experiments of Indian (E)presence.

A.A-D; B-C

B.A-C; B-E

C.C-D; A-E

D.D-C; B-A

E.No interchange is required.

Answer : C

Among the given highlighted words, an interchange is required between D-C and A-E. Here, 'federalism of Article 370' sounds incorrect. Among the remaining highlighted words only 'presence' can make the phrase correct. Further, 'erroneous' followed by 'to' is grammatically incorrect. The correct phrase will be 'contrary to'. Hence, option (c) is correct.



Federalism- the federal principle or system of government.

Weakened- make or become weaker in power, resolve, or physical strength.

Contrary- opposite in nature, direction, or meaning.

Erroneous- wrong/ incorrect.

Presence- the state or fact of existing, occurring, or being present.

2) For a long time, major parties (A) aftermath Sri Lankan Tamils preferred to focus onpolitical (B) empowerment of the Tamil s instead of socio-economic (C) development of the two Provinces, (D) regardless of the impact of the civil war and its (E) representing on livelihoods.

A.A-D; B-C

B.A-C

Answer: C

Among the given highlighted words, (A) and (E) have been incorrectly placed. The hint can be drawn from the latter part of the sentence, because prepositions are used with a noun, pronoun, or noun phrase to show direction, time, place, location, spatial relationships, or to introduce an object. Here, 'representing' is a verb and must be replaced with 'aftermath'. Hence, option (c) is correct.

Aftermath (noun) - the consequences or aftereffects of a significant unpleasant event.



Representing (verb)- be entitled or appointed to act or speak for (someone), especially in an official capacity.

3) Way back in 1897, the British (A) empowered the Epidemic Diseases Act which (B) enacted the government to (C) prevent any measures that would (D) implement the outbreak or (E) spread of any disease.

A.A-D; B-C

B.A-C; B-E

E. No interchange is required.

Answer: D

Among the given highlighted words, aninterchange is required between D-C and B-A.Here, we can get the hint from the former partof the sentence because 'laws are enacted' and they 'empower someone'. Also, the outbreak shouldn't be implemented, instead it should be 'stopped'. Therefore, 'implement' and 'prevent' should be interchanged. Hence, option (d) is correct.

Enacted - make (a bill or other proposal) law.

Empowered- give (someone) the authority or power to do something.

Implement- put (a decision, plan, agreement, etc.) into effect.

Prevent- keep (something) from happening.

Spread - gradually reach or cause to reach awider area or more people.

Among the given highlighted words, an interchange is required between D-C and A-B. Here, 'States' must be preceded by an adjective instead of a verb. Therefore, (A)-(B) will be interchanged. Subsequently, 'was' will be followed by a past tense verb. Here, the correct replacement will be with 'defended'. Hence, option (d) is correct.

Reorganization- the action or process of changing the way in which something is organized.

Erstwhile- former.

Defended- resist an attack made on (someone or something); protect from harm or danger.

Lead- culminate or result in (a particular eventor consequence).

Integration- the action or process of integrating.

Answer: E

All the given highlighted words have been correctly placed and do not require any interchange. Hence, option (e) is correct.
