

# SBI PO Exam Pattern & Syllabus for Prelims and Mains 2026

The SBI PO exam is held every year to recruit candidates for the post of Probationary Officer in State Bank of India branches across the country. It is a national-level exam that includes three main stages: Prelims, Mains, and a Psychometric Test, followed by an Interview or Group Exercises. To apply, candidates must have a graduation degree from a recognized university. The exam checks skills in aptitude, reasoning, English, and general awareness. Those who clear all stages go through a two-year probation period before becoming permanent officers in the bank.

## **SBI PO Exam Pattern**

### **Prelims :-**

The Prelims exam is the initial stage of the SBI PO 2026 selection process, conducted online. It is a qualifying exam, and candidates need to meet the cut-off to progress to the next phase. A negative marking system is in place, where a 1/4th mark is deducted for each incorrect answer. The exam has a total of 100 marks, and there is no sectional weightage.

### **Mains:-**

The Mains stage of the SBI PO 2026 exam consists of two parts: **the Objective Test and the Descriptive Test**. The Objective Test is the first part, followed by the Descriptive Test. Candidates need to clear both the minimum qualifying marks in each section and the Descriptive Paper to progress. The cut-off for each section is determined based on the number of vacancies, and only those who qualify will proceed to Phase III.

- Objective Test:** This includes 170 questions spread across four sections, with a total of 200 marks. The duration for this section is 180 minutes (3 hours), and there is a negative marking of 0.25 marks for each incorrect answer.
- Descriptive Test:** This section tests your communication skills through tasks like Emails, Reports, Situation Analysis, and Precis Writing. It carries a total of 50 marks and must be completed in 30 minutes.

## **SBI PO Selection Process**

<b>Stage</b>	<b>Details</b>
Prelims Exam	This is the first stage. It's an online objective test used to shortlist candidates for Mains. Marks from this stage are not counted in the final result.
Mains Exam	The second stage includes both objective and descriptive papers. Marks scored here are important for the final merit list.
Interview & Group Discussion	Final stage where your communication skills, personality, and awareness are tested. Only those who clear the Mains are called.
Final Selection	Based on Mains marks (75%) and Interview/GD marks (25%). Prelims is only for screening.
