**Guinea coup leader Doumbouya
wins presidential election**

**गिनी के तख्तापलट के नेता डौम्बौया ने

1. Background

Coup leader Mamady Doumbouya elected President (provisional results).

Marks a formal return to civilian rule after the 2021 coup.

Guinea is rich in bauxite and iron ore.

2. Election Results

Doumbouya won 86.72% of votes (Dec 28 election).

Secures a 7-year term and avoids a runoff.

Supreme Court has 8 days to validate results.

3. Political Context

Doumbouya toppled Alpha Condé in 2021.

Part of a wave of nine coups in West & Central Africa since 2020.

Major rivals Condé and Cellou Dalein Diallo are in exile.

4. Pledge Reversed

Post-coup charter originally barred junta members from contesting.

A new constitution (Sept referendum) removed the restriction.

Turnout announced as 80.95%, but opposition disputes figures.



5. Resource Strategy

Guinea has:

Largest bauxite reserves worldwide

Massive Simandou iron ore project (recently launched)

Government asserted stronger control over resources, including revoking a major refinery licence.

“Resource nationalism” boosted Doumbouya’s popularity.

Reports of restricted political space:

intimidation allegations

UN says campaign period was severely restricted.

Opposition claims fraud and blocked observers.

World Blitz: Magnus Carlsen wins record-extending 9th title

1. Historic Achievement

Magnus Carlsen wins his record-extending 9th World Blitz title.

Adds it to the Rapid gold he won two days earlier.

Event held in Doha. ✓

2. Final vs Abdusattorov

Faced Nodirbek Abdusattorov (Uzbekistan) in the final.

Refused an easy draw and found a brilliant pawn move in Game 4.

Won the match 2.5 – 1.5 after being tied 1.5–1.5.

3. Comeback Story

Struggled during the Swiss rounds, even losing multiple games.

Qualified narrowly for semifinals after drawing Abdusattorov in Round 19.

4. Road to the Title

Semifinal: Carlsen beat Fabiano Caruana 3–1.

Abdusattorov defeated Arjun Erigaisi 2.5–0.5 to reach the final.

5. Arjun Erigaisi's Milestone

Erigaisi won bronze in Blitz (and bronze in Rapid earlier).

Becomes only the second Indian male (after Viswanathan Anand)

to win a World Blitz medal in the Open category.



1. Delhi Cabinet Clears Jan Vishwas (Amendment) Bill, 2026

Aim: decriminalise minor offences

Focus: ease of doing business & ease of living

Reduces burden on courts and improves administration.

2. What Changes?

Minor, technical & procedural violations →

civil penalties + administrative fines + appeals system.

Serious offences will NOT be diluted.

Public health, safety, and life-related provisions remain strict.

3. Expected Outcomes

Lower litigation

Faster administrative decisions

Proportional, fair punishment

Delhi Industrial Development, O&M Act, 2010

5. Penalties & Implementation

Minor offences → converted to civil penalties

Automatic 10% increase in fines every 3 years (inflation-linked)

1. What is PathGennie?

A new computational framework to simulate rare molecular events.

Developed at S. N. Bose National Centre for Basic Sciences (DST, Govt. of India).

Published in the Journal of Chemical Theory and Computation.

2. Key Problem it Solves

Difficulty in simulating ligand unbinding (how drugs detach from proteins).

Unbinding influences drug residence time — crucial for therapeutic effectiveness.

Traditional simulations:

Need huge computing power

Take very long time

Often distort physics using artificial forces or high temperatures.

3. How PathGennie Works

Uses direction-guided adaptive sampling.

Runs many very short unbiased simulations.

Selectively extends only those moving toward the goal.

Discards unproductive paths.



Preserves natural kinetic pathways — no external forcing.

4. Why It's Important

Significantly reduces simulation time.

Maintains accuracy and physical realism.

Helps predict:

Drug exit routes from proteins

Drug residence time

Validated by:

T4 lysozyme–benzene system

Imatinib (anti-cancer drug) unbinding from Abl kinase.

5. Wider Applications

Drug discovery and design

Chemical reactions

Catalysis

Phase transitions

Self-assembly systems

Compatible with machine learning–based models.

Known globally as the "Oracle of Omaha."

2. Investment Philosophy

Focused on value investing, patience, and long-term compounding.
Prioritized disciplined capital allocation and conservative risk management.

3. Major Holdings & Businesses

Significant stakes: Apple, Coca-Cola, American Express, Bank of America.
Owns companies like BNSF Railway, GEICO, Berkshire Hathaway Energy, and many others.

4. Leadership Transition

Greg Abel to become CEO effective January 1, 2026.
Abel has led non-insurance operations and expanded energy/infrastructure businesses.



5. Buffett's Future Role

Buffett will remain Chairman.

Move aims to maintain continuity, culture, and investor confidence.
