



Passed away in Pune, age 81, after prolonged illness.

Former President, Indian Olympic Association (IOA)

Major figure in Indian sports administration.

3. Early Life & Education

Born May 1, 1944 — Madras (Chennai)

Schooling: St. Vincent's High School, Pune

College: Fergusson College, Pune

Military training: NDA, Khadakwasla, later aviation training at Air Force Flying Colleges.

4. Entry into Politics

Entered electoral politics in 1982

Initially linked to Congress (S) under Sharad Pawar



Later joined reunited Indian National Congress (INC) in 1986.

5. Parliamentary Career

Rajya Sabha: Multiple terms (1982–2004)

Lok Sabha: Three terms — 1996, 2004, 2009 from Pune constituency.

6. Indian Olympic Association Leadership

IOA President from 1996–2011

Re-elected several times; did not contest again in 2012 under IOC pressure.

7. Commonwealth Games Controversy

Arrested by CBI (2011) over CWG 2010 corruption allegations

Accused in contracts related to Timing, Scoring & Results (TSR) system

Denied allegations; legal process continued.

8. International Athletics Role

Served as President, Asian Athletics Association (1999–2013)

Received AAA President's Award (2015).

1. Zelenskyy appoints Chrystia Freeland

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy signed a decree appointing Chrystia Freeland as Adviser on Economic Development.

Zelenskyy said she brings investment experience and economic reform expertise.

2. Focus on Ukraine's Internal Resilience

Zelenskyy stressed the need to:

strengthen internal resilience,

support recovery if diplomacy succeeds,

reinforce defence if the war continues due to delays by partners.

3. About Chrystia Freeland

Former Canadian Deputy Prime Minister (2019–2024).

Active lawmaker in Canada's parliament.

**State-run banks' headcount rises for first time in 5 years;
Private banks' dips 0.9%**

1. Public Sector Banks: First Rise in Staff in 5 Years

Employee count of public sector banks (PSBs) increased for the first time since 2017 merger waves.

PSB headcount rose 0.22% to 7,57,641 (FY25) from 7,56,015 (FY24).

2. Private Banks: Headcount Declines

Private banks' employee strength fell 0.86% to 8,38,150 (FY25) from 8,45,407 (FY24).

Focus on technology, digitisation, and productivity instead of hiring.

3. Background: Bank Mergers Since 2017

SBI merged 5 associate banks + Bharatiya Mahila Bank (2017).

Major consolidation in 2020: 12 banks merged into 4 big entities.

Discussions underway about a third wave of mergers.


4. Major Mergers (2020 Wave)

PNB + OBC + United Bank → 2nd largest PSB.

Canara Bank + Syndicate Bank → large combined entity.

Union Bank + Andhra Bank + Corporation Bank → bigger network.

Indian Bank + Allahabad Bank → stronger mid-sized bank.





5. SBI and PNB Hiring Trends

SBI headcount: 2,36,226 (+3,930).

PNB headcount: 1,02,746 (+397).

SBI plans to hire 18,000 more in FY26 (mostly clerical + POs).

Joe Root equals Ricky Ponting's record for third-most Test centuries during Ashes final

1. Root equals Ponting's Test century record

Joe Root scored a brilliant 160 runs off 242 balls in the Sydney Test (Ashes 2025–26).

This became his 41st Test century.

2. Mixed Ashes campaign

Overall, Root had a rough series and could not perform consistently.

Despite his effort, Australia retained the Ashes.

3. Two centuries in the series

Root earlier broke his century drought in Australia with his 40th hundred in the 2nd Test.

Added another century in the final Test.

4. Elite list — Most Test Hundreds

Root is now joint 3rd with Ricky Ponting (41 hundreds).

Ahead of him are:

Jacques Kallis — 45

Sachin Tendulkar — 51

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

1. Which airports are being privatised (Round-3)?

Total: 11 airports, grouped into 5 bundles

Bundles:

- Amritsar – Kangra
- Varanasi – Kushinagar – Gaya
- Bhubaneswar – Hubli
- Raipur – Aurangabad
- Tiruchi – Tirupati

2. What is the process?

Proposal sent to PPPAC for appraisal.

After Cabinet approval → bids invited.

Tender likely by March 2026.

Airports selected from AAI list handling 0.1–1 million passengers/year.

Selection based on:

traffic growth projections



investment needs

proximity (for bundling)

3. Background of privatisation

Started in 2003 (NDA government).

Delhi & Mumbai → privatised in 2006 (GMR, GVK).

Greenfield PPP airports: Bengaluru, Hyderabad.

2019: 6 airports privatised (all to Adani).

Model shifted from revenue-share → per-passenger fee.

4. Link with National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP)

NMP target (2021–25): ₹6 lakh crore. ✓


Airport contribution target: ₹20,782 crore (~4%). ✓

Aviation sector still lagging in monetisation delivery. ✓

New plan announced: Asset Monetisation Plan 2025–30 → target ₹10 lakh crore.

5. Key issues under evaluation

Revenue-share vs per-passenger fee





Cross-subsidy between metro & non-metro airports

Cap on airports awarded to one entity

Use of land for non-aero revenues

Whether UDF will be airport-wise or bundle-wise

6. Concerns & risks

Rising monopoly dominance (Adani operating 8 airports).

Reduced bargaining power for airlines.

Higher costs for passengers.

Example: Thiruvananthapuram

UDF rise: ₹506 → ₹770 (domestic; then further hikes)

New disembarkation fee introduced

Under-reporting of non-aero revenue flagged by regulator (AERA)

7. Impact on passengers

Higher airfare (UDF, landing, disembarkation fees)

Complaints: expensive taxis, congestion, poor accessibility



New approach: penalties (up to 5% tariff cut) if service benchmarks not met
Benchmarks include:

wait time, check-in time, help desks, terminal transfer time, etc.

8. What lies ahead?

Only ~6% Indians travel by air → large growth potential.

Plan: 50 new airports in next five years.

Capacity target by FY2026: ~550 mppa, rising to ~850 mppa soon after.

Needs:

more airports

strong private investment

financially stable airlines

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
