Q1. Which Indian film became the first from India to win the BAFTA Award for Best Children's & Family Film in 2026?

Sol. Answer: (b) Boong

Solution

- In February 2026, the Manipuri-language film Boong won the BAFTA Award for Best Children's & Family Film.
- It was honoured at the 79th edition of the ceremony held at the Royal Festival Hall, London.
- The film was directed by debutant Lakshmipriya Devi.
- Produced by Farhan Akhtar and Ritesh Sidhwani under Excel Entertainment.
- It became the first Indian film to win in this category at the BAFTA Awards.

Sol. Answer: (a) 1 and 2 only

Solution

- The Milano Cortina 2026 were held from 6–22 February 2026 in Italy.
- Statement 1 is correct: It marked the first time two cities—Milan and Cortina d'Ampezzo—officially co-hosted the Winter Olympics.
- Statement 2 is correct: Norway topped the medal tally with 18 gold, 12 silver, and 11 bronze (41 total).
- Statement 3 is incorrect: India did not win a medal, though Arif Mohammad Khan recorded India's best-ever finish in men's slalom.

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Top 3 Nations (Medal Tally)

- Norway – 41 medals (18 Gold)
- USA – 33 medals (12 Gold)
- Netherlands – 20 medals (10 Gold)

Host Nation – Italy

- Finished 4th
- Best-ever Winter Olympic performance (30 medals)

Solution

- On 22 February 2026, Narendra Modi flagged off the Delhi–Meerut Namu Bharat Corridor in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh.
- Statement 1 is correct: It is India's first Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS).
- Statement 2 is correct: The corridor is designed for 180 kmph with an operational speed of 160 kmph.
- Statement 3 is incorrect: The Meerut Metro operates on shared infrastructure with the Namu Bharat corridor, forming India's first integrated intercity and intra-city rapid transit model.

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Delhi–Meerut Namu Bharat Corridor

- Length: 82 km
- Originating Station: Sarai Kale Khan
- Connects: Delhi, Sahibabad, Ghaziabad, Modinagar, Meerut

Meerut Metro

- Length: 21 km

Solution

- On 20 February 2026, Jagat Prakash Nadda launched the indigenously manufactured Td vaccine.
- The launch took place at Central Research Institute Kasauli.
- Td vaccine combines tetanus toxoid and diphtheria toxoid for dual protection.
- It replaces the earlier TT (Tetanus Toxoid) vaccine in many cases.
- Incorporated into India's Universal Immunization Programme (UIP).
- CRI is set to supply 55 lakh doses by April 2026.

- During the event, Cohort 2 of AMRITVA (Alliance for Medical Research, Innovation, Translation & Value Acceleration) was launched.
- AMRITVA is implemented by the Startup Incubation and Innovation Centre (SIIC) of Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur.
- Five innovators were selected under Cohort 2 for grant support to commercialize research.

- Amitabh Bachchan was appointed as the Brand Ambassador for SIDH.

Solution

- In February 2026, Embraer partnered with Mahindra Group.
- The collaboration aims to establish an MRO facility in India for the C-390 Millennium.
- The facility is subject to the aircraft's selection by the Indian Air Force under the Medium Transport Aircraft (MTA) programme.
- The proposed MRO will provide base & heavy maintenance, structural testing, avionics support, component overhaul, and training services.
- The C-390 has a payload capacity of up to 26 tons and is designed for multi-mission military transport roles.

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Strategic Context

- Strategic Cooperation Agreement (SCA) signed in October 2025
- Supports the Make in India initiative
- Focus on in-country sustainment & operational readiness

C-390 Key Features

- Multi-mission transport aircraft
- Payload capacity: Up to 26 tons
- Higher speed & operational range compared to other medium transport aircraft

- It became the only religious site from India to receive recognition in the 2025 edition.
- The announcement was made in Bangkok, Thailand, during the 25th anniversary ceremony.
- The awards are organised by UNESCO under four categories including Award of Distinction and Award of Merit.
- The highest honour (Award of Distinction) in 2025 was jointly given to:
 - Sihang Warehouse (China)
 - Iwami Ginzan Library (Japan)

- Belgium's Hanne Vandewinkel clinched the ITF W100 Bengaluru Women's Singles title.
- She defeated India's Vaishnavi Adkar in the final (6-0, 6-1).
- The tournament was held at SM Krishna Tennis Stadium, Bengaluru (16-22 February 2026).
- Vandewinkel earned 100 WTA ranking points and USD 15,239 as prize money.
- Vaishnavi Adkar earned 65 ranking points and USD 8,147.
- Adkar became the first Indian woman since Sania Mirza (2009) to reach an ITF W100 final.

- Official translations are now also available in Boro, Dogri, Santali, and other regional languages.
- The initiative aims to promote constitutional awareness in citizens' mother tongues.
- He also launched the 8th edition of the Legal Glossary translating legal terms from English to Hindi.
