

The SBI PO syllabus is very similar to that of any other bank exam. There are three major sections that a candidate needs to prepare to ace the preliminary exam. These are Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude and English Language. The sections have a wide range of topics on which questions are based. It is recommended that candidates have a look at the previous year's papers and know about the weightage of each topic.

SBI PO Syllabus and Exam Pattern 2026

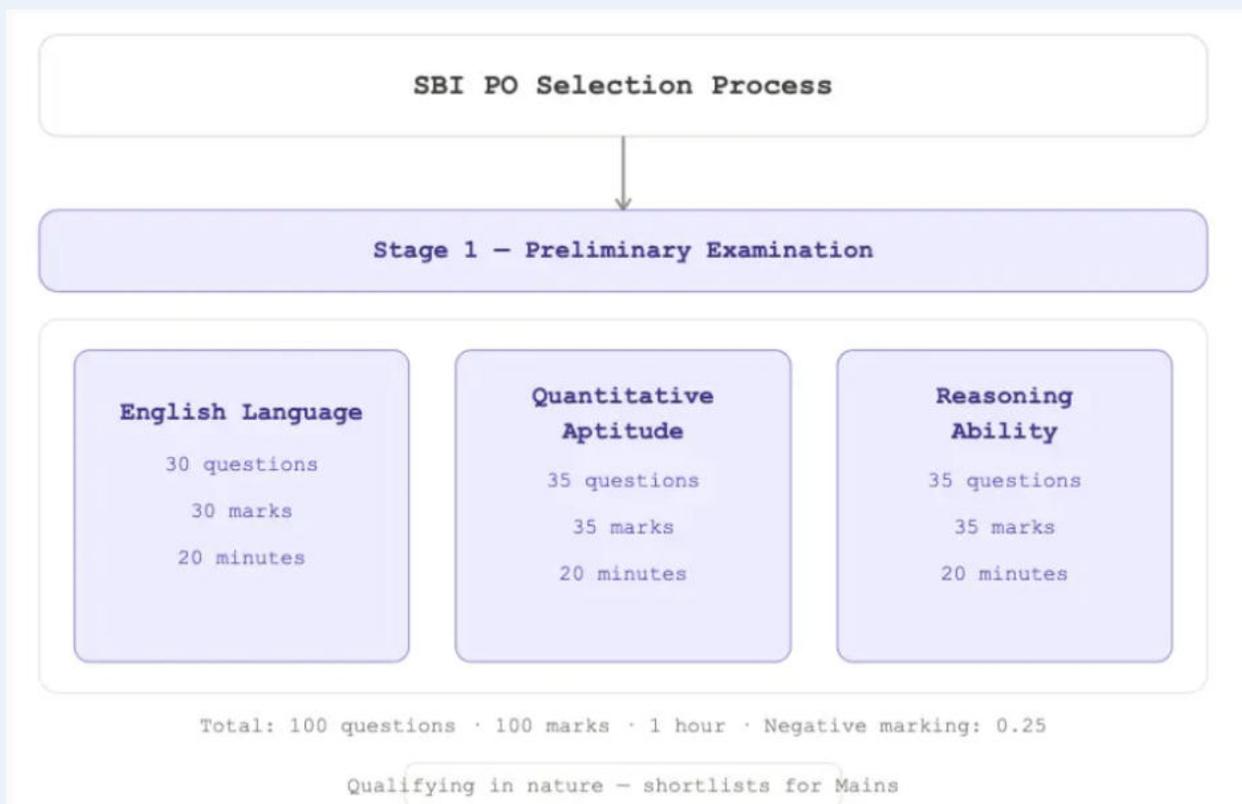
The preliminary examination of the SBI PO 2026 comprises of 100 questions from Reasoning Ability, Quantitative Aptitude and English Language. The main examination of SBI PO 2026 comprises Reasoning and Computer Aptitude, Data Analysis and Interpretation, General/Economy/Banking Awareness, English Language, and a descriptive test. State Bank of India (SBI) will recruit candidates through three stages: Preliminary Examination, Mains Examination, and Interview.





SBI PO Exam Pattern 2026

State Bank of India (SBI) conducts 2 stages of online examination i.e. Preliminary and Mains. Only the candidates qualifying in both stages will be eligible to appear for the interview round. For each incorrect answer in the objective test, there will be a negative marking of 0.25

SBI PO Descriptive Test 2026

The **Descriptive Paper of 30 minutes duration with two questions for 50 marks** will be a Test of English Language (Letter Writing & Essay).

Besides the preliminary exam and the main exam, an interview process is also conducted for candidates who qualify for the first two phases of the SBI PO exam.

The final merit list is made based on marks obtained by a candidate in his/ her main exam and interview process.
