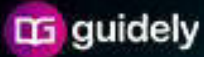

$$JZ = 10 + 26 = 36 = 6^2$$

$$RG = 18 + 7 = 25 = 5^2$$

$$XY = 24 + 25 = 49 = 7^2$$

$$QE = 17 + 5 = 22$$

$$GI = 7 + 9 = 16 = 4^2$$

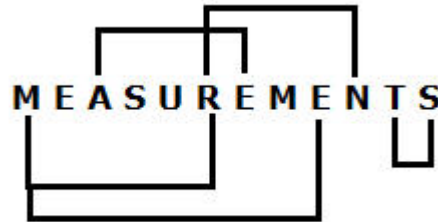
The place value of the letters is an odd number.
