Ten persons are sitting in the two parallel rows and facing each other. In Row1 A, B, C, D, and E are sitting and facing south. In row2 H, I, J, K and L are sitting and facing north but not necessarily in the same order.

I sits third to the right of L. B sits opposite to L. A sits second to the left of B. The number of persons sitting between B and A is the same as the number of persons sitting between L and K. C and I sitting opposite to each other. Neither D nor E sits adjacent to C. E sits to the left of B. J and E does not sit opposite to each other.

Ten persons viz. G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O and P are sitting in two parallel rows such that the

persons in row 1 faces north while the persons in row 2 faces south and all the persons are facing towards each other, but not necessarily in the same order.

Only one person sits between G and J, who faces I and neither G nor J sits at the end of the row. H sits third to the left of I whereas L faces north and sits at the end of the row but doesn't sit adjacent to J. Only one person sits between L and the one who faces P. N sits adjacent to G and faces the one who sits second to the left of M. K neither sits at the end of the row nor adjacent to P.

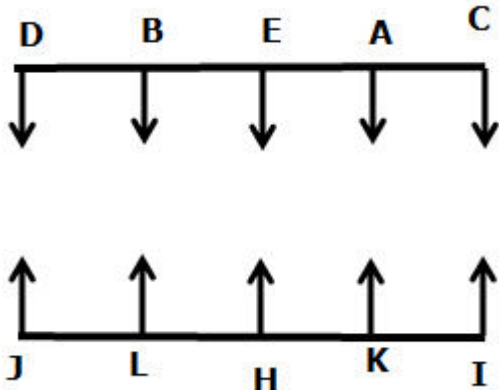

Direction (1-5):

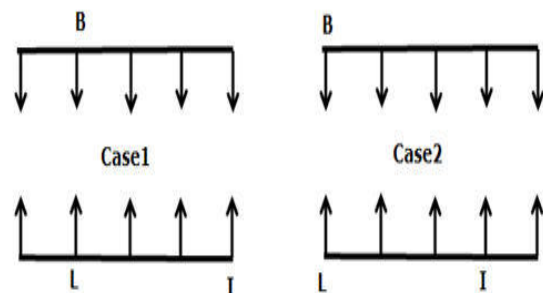
1. Answer: D

We have,

- I sits third to the right of L.
- B sits opposite to L.

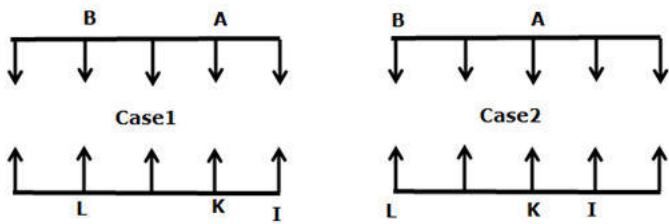
From the above condition, there are two possibilities.



Again we have,

- A sits second to the left of B.
- The number of persons sitting between B and A is the same as the number of persons sitting between L and K.

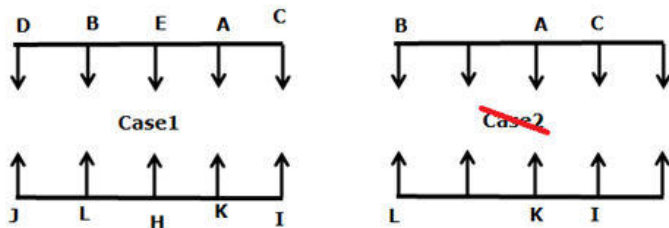


Again we have,

- C and I sitting opposite to each other.
- Neither D nor E sits adjacent to C.
- E sits to the left of B.
- J and E do not sit opposite to each other.

From the above condition, case2 gets eliminated.

Case1 shows the final arrangement.

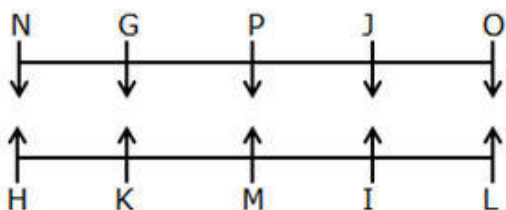

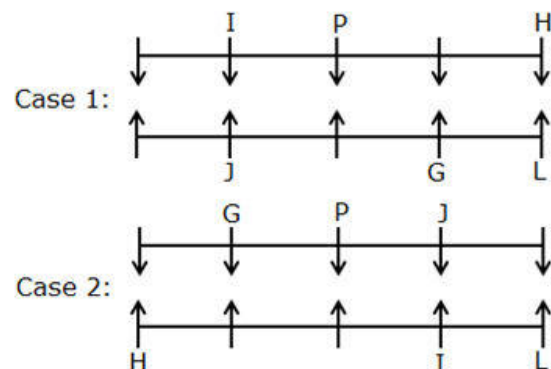

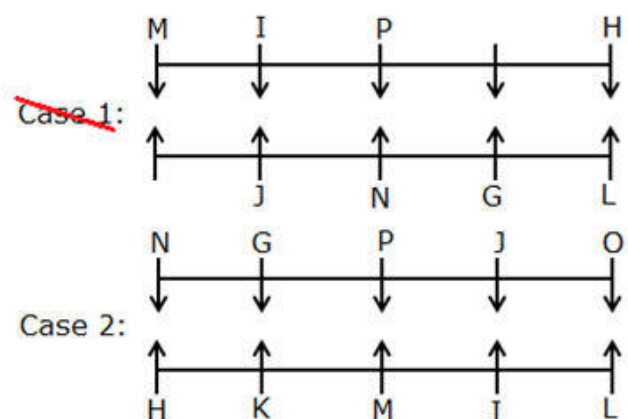


- Only one person sits between G and J, who faces I and neither G nor J sits at the end of the row.
- H sits third to the left of I whereas L faces north and sits at the end of the row but doesn't sit adjacent to J.
- Only one person sits between L and the one who faces P.



- N sits adjacent to G and faces the one who sits second to the left of M.
- K neither sits at the end of the row nor adjacent to P.

Hence, case 1 gets eliminated.
