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## Month With Day Based Puzzle for Bank Exam – Question Bank Set 2(Eng)

**Direction (1-5):** Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given below.

Eight persons A, B, C, D, E, F, G, and H are attending online exams on different dates 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of four different months January, February, April, and May. Only one person attends the online exam on a day.

D attends the online exam on the 8<sup>th</sup> of a month having less than 31 days. Two persons attend the online exam between D and G. Only one person attends the online exam between A and B, who attends the online exam immediately before G. As many persons attend the online exam before A as the persons attend the online exam after F. C attends the online exam on 5<sup>th</sup> but not on the month having less than 30 days. E attends the exam after H, but not immediately after H.

Ten persons namely A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I and J have seminar on two different dates viz. 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of five different months among March, April, June, July and September of a same year, but not necessarily in the given order.

E and I have seminar in a month having 31 days and 30 days respectively. At least three persons have seminar before E and after I. Both B and I have seminar in the same month. G has seminar in one of the months before B. Only three persons have seminar between G and H. C has seminar four months before H but not on an even numbered date. D, who has seminar in April, has seminar in one of the months before A and one of the months after F. Both F and J doesn't have seminar on the same numbered date. More than two persons have seminar between J and I. Both D and I have seminar on the same numbered date.

We have,

- D attends the online exam on the 8<sup>th</sup> of a month having less than 31 days.
- Two persons attend the online exam between D and G.

From the above condition, there are three possibilities.

Again we have,

- Only one person attends the online exam between A and B, who attends the online exam immediately before G.
- As many persons attend the online exam before A as the persons who attend the online exam after F.
- C attends the online exam on the 5<sup>th</sup> but not on the month having less than 30 days.
- E attends the exam after H, but not immediately after H.

Both F and J doesn't have seminar on the same numbered date.
