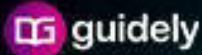


Square Seating arrangement for Bank Exam – Question Bank Set 2 (Eng)



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Directions (1-5): Study the following information carefully and answer the below questions

Eight persons- L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, and S are sitting at the square table such that four of them sit at the corner and four of them sit in the middle of the table. All are facing the centre. All the information is not necessarily in the same order.

The consecutive alphabetical names of the persons are not sitting together.

P sits third to the left of the one who sits second to the right of L. P sits corner of the table. Only one person sits between L and N. R and N are immediate neighbours. The number of persons sits between L and R is the same as the number of persons sit between P and O. Only one person sits between M and S.

1) What is the position of N with respect to S?

table facing outside. Four of them are sitting at each corner and four of them are sitting at each sides of the table at an equal distance. All the information is not necessarily in the same order. Siva sits third to the left of the Jothi. One person sits between Jothi and Kani. The one who sits opposite Kani sits adjacent to Hari. Hari sits at the corner of the table. Malar sits immediately right of the one who sits second to the right of Raju.

Malar doesn't sit at the corner. Raju sits third to the right of Bala. Ashu neither sits adjacent to Bala nor Raju. Number of persons who sits between malar and Ashu is same as between Hari and Jothi

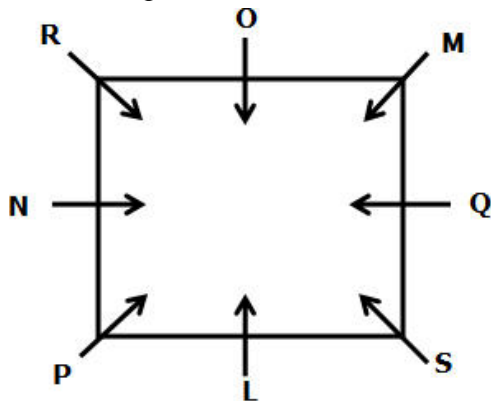

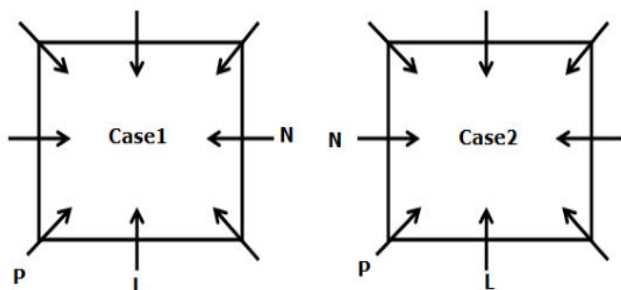
Final Arrangement



We have,

- P sits third to the left of the one who sits second to the right of L.
- P sits corner of the table.
- Only one person sits between L and N.

From the above condition, there are two possibilities.

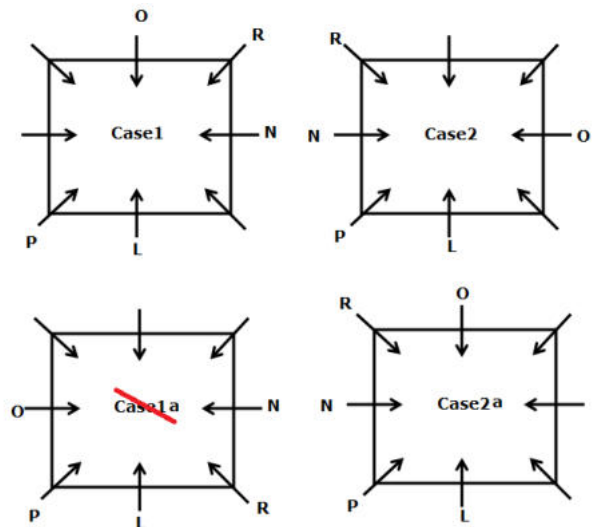


Again we have,

- R and N are immediate neighbours.

- The number of persons sit between L and R is the same as the number of persons sit between P and O.

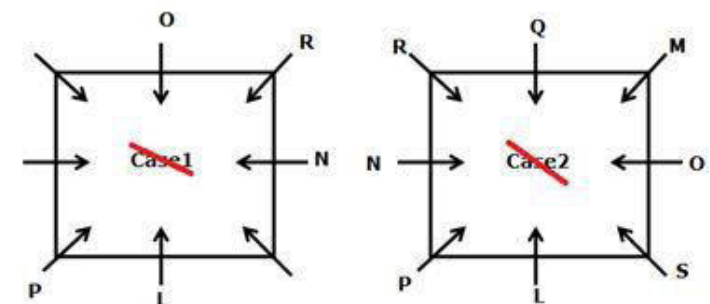
From the above condition, there are three possibilities.



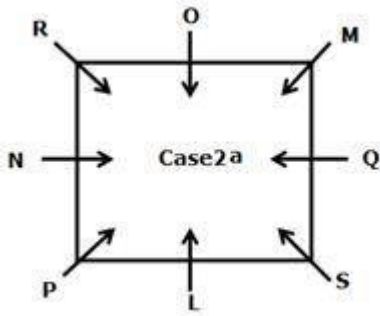
Again we have,

- Only one person sits between M and S.

From the above condition, case1 and case2 get eliminated. case2a shows the final Arrangement.

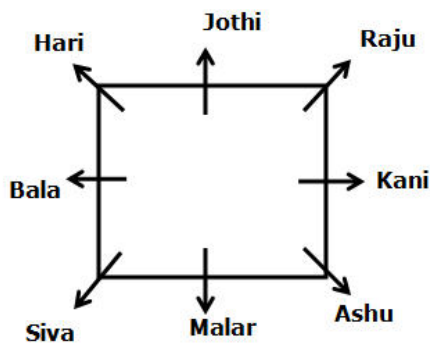

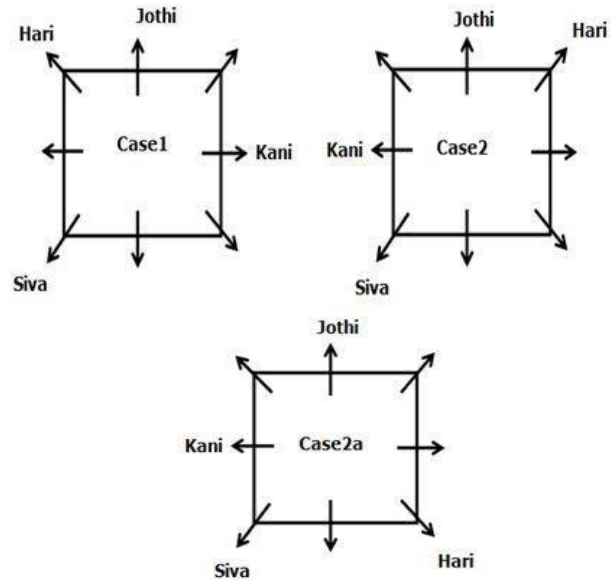
Final arrangement



We have,

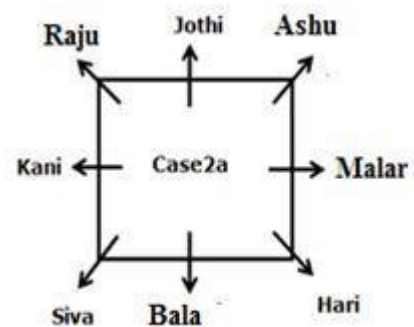
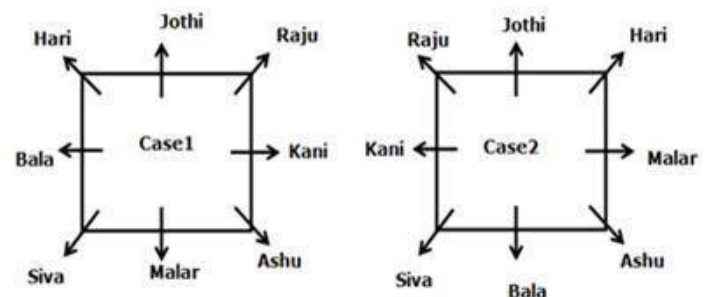
- Siva sits third to the left of the Jothi.
- One person sits between Jothi and Kani.
- The one who sits opposite Kani sits adjacent to Hari.
- Hari sits at the corner of the table.

From the above condition, there are three possibilities.



Again we have,

- Malar sits immediately right of the one who sits second to the right of Raju. Malar doesn't sit at the corner.
- Raju sits third to the right of Bala.

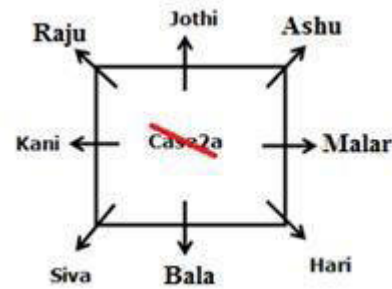
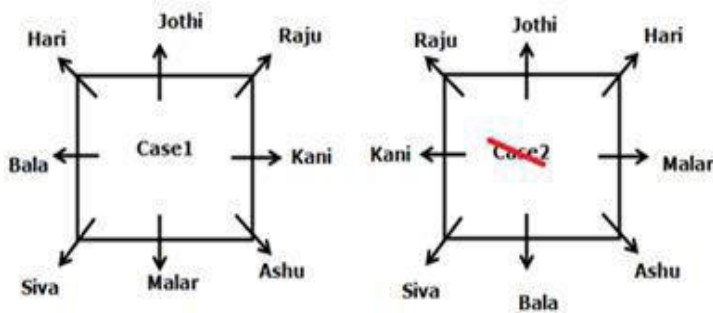


Again we have,

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- Ashu neither sits adjacent to Bala nor Raju. Number of persons who sits between malar and Ashu is same as between Hari and Jothi

From the above condition case2 and case2a get eliminated. case1 shows the final arrangement.



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
