* Electronic Signature :-

- Electronic Signature means authentication of electronic records by subscriber by means of electronic technique.
- Specified in "Second Schedule" and includes digital signature.

Digital Signature :-

- Authentication of any electronic record by a subscriber by means of an electronic method or procedure in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.

* Digital Signature is a part of electronic Signature.

Section 79 Exemption of liability of intermediary in Certain Cases.

- Intermediary is like Social media platform or Isp (Internet Service Providers) are exempted from liability for third party Content Hosted or transmitted through them. Provided they :

- (a) Only provide access to Communication System.
- (b) Don't initiate, Select the receiver or alter the Content.
- (c) follow due diligence and government prescribed guidelines.

- They loose this exemption if,

- (i) Participate or Support in Unlawful activities.
- (ii) failed to remove or disable access to Unlawful Content after receiving knowledge or notification from the government.
