Q1. In April 2026, PLR Systems delivered the first batch of NEGEV 7.62×51 Light Machine Guns (LMGs) to India as part of which initiative?

Sol. Answer: (b)

Solution

- The delivery of NEGEV LMGs was carried out under the 'Make in India' initiative
- It involved technology transfer and domestic manufacturing
- Hence, the correct answer is (b)

Information Booster

- Delivered by PLR Systems
- Joint venture between Israel Weapon Industries (IWI) and Adani Group
- First batch: 2,000 LMGs delivered on 1 April 2026
- Part of larger order of 41,000 LMGs (August 2024 contract)

Additional Knowledge

- Manufactured at Malanpur, Madhya Pradesh
- Uses 7.62×51 mm ammunition
- Supports semi-automatic and fully automatic firing modes
- NATO-compliant and suitable for urban and high-intensity combat
- PLR Systems also secured contract for 170,000 CQB carbines

- He replaced Amarendu Prakash, who resigned

Information Booster

- Appointment approved by Ministry of Steel
- Effective from April 2, 2026
- SAIL is a Maharatna PSU in steel sector
- Interim arrangement for leadership continuity

Additional Knowledge

- Amarendu Prakash resigned effective April 1, 2026
- Power Grid Corporation of India Limited appointed Burra Vamsi Rama Mohan as CMD
- His tenure runs till July 31, 2030
- He succeeded Ravindra Kumar Tyagi
- POWERGRID operates under Ministry of Power

Q3. In April 2026, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the 'Karmayogi Sadhana Saptah 2026' under which initiative?

- Organised by Capacity Building Commission (CBC)
- Duration: April 2–8, 2026
- Marks 5 years of Mission Karmayogi

Additional Knowledge

- Mission Karmayogi aims at civil services reform and competency development
- Based on pillars: Technology, Tradition, Tangible Outcomes
- Key initiatives: Karmayogi Geet, Kshamata Connect, Kartavya Karyakram
- Includes AI-powered Case Study Suite (AGK)
- Focus on building a future-ready governance ecosystem

Q4. In April 2026, Microsoft signed an MoU with Chandigarh University to establish an AI Skill Center in which state?

- Offers certifications like AZ-900, DP-900, AI-900
- Includes hands-on labs and Microsoft Azure training

Additional Knowledge

- Provides access to 4,400+ Microsoft learning modules
- Collaboration with byteXL for AI and GenAI programs
- CU to launch B.E. CSE (AI specialization) and online MCA courses
- Supports 'AI for All' initiative
- Enhances industry-ready skills and employability of students

Q5. In April 2026, who was elected as the 11th President of Myanmar?

- Occurred in April 2026
- Parliament dominated by military-backed USDP
- Two Vice-Presidents elected: Nan Ni Ni Aye and U Nyo Saw

Additional Knowledge

- Min Aung Hlaing is the former Commander-in-Chief of Tatmadaw
- Tatmadaw refers to Myanmar's armed forces
- Pyidaungsu Hluttaw is the bicameral legislature of Myanmar
- Election reflects military influence in Myanmar politics
- Total parliamentary strength: 584 members

Q6. The International Children's Book Day is observed annually on which date, and what was its theme for 2026?

Solution

- International Children’s Book Day is observed on April 2 every year
- The 2026 theme is “Plant stories and the world will bloom”
- The day marks the birth anniversary of Hans Christian Andersen

Information Booster

- First observed in 1967
- Organised by International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY)
- Supported by UNESCO
- Aims to promote children’s literature and reading habits

Additional Knowledge

- Hans Christian Andersen is known as “father of modern fantasy”
- 2026 host country: IBBY Cyprus
- Featured contributors: Elena Perikleous (poem)
- Poster illustrated by Sandra Eleftheriou
- Encourages creativity, empathy, and lifelong learning through books

Q7. In April 2026, the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) launched the ‘Kar Saathi’ portal for which of the following purposes?

Solution

- ‘Kar Saathi’ is an AI-powered portal launched to simplify tax filing
- It provides 24×7 assistance through an AI chatbot
- Offers support for queries and compliance under Income Tax Act, 2025

Information Booster

- Launched in April 2026 by CBDT
- Falls under Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance
- Linked with PRARAMBH 2026 campaign
- Provides bilingual support (Hindi & English)
- Acts as a unified platform for tax-related information

Additional Knowledge

- PRARAMBH aims at policy reform and ease of compliance
- Rules reduced from 510 to 333
- Forms reduced from 399 to 190
- Eliminated need for over 6 crore transactions
- Enhances ease of doing business and taxpayer convenience

Q8. In April 2026, the National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) partnered with which organisation to launch India's first domestic benchmark natural gas derivatives?

- Based on Gas IndeX of India (GIXI)
- Aims to improve risk management and market efficiency

Additional Knowledge

- IGX is India's first automated national-level gas trading platform
- Operates under Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB)
- GIXI reflects real-time domestic gas price discovery
- Futures contracts help in hedging price volatility
- Initiative boosts transparency, liquidity, and investor participation in gas market

Q9. In April 2026, INS Taragiri (F41), commissioned into the Indian Navy, is part of which project?

- (a) Project 15B
- (b) Project 75
- (c) Project 17A

Solution

- INS Taragiri is the fourth stealth frigate under Project 17A
- Built to enhance naval combat and stealth capabilities

Information Booster

- Commissioned in April 2026 at Visakhapatnam
- Commissioned by Rajnath Singh
- Built by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL)
- Part of advanced stealth frigate programme

Additional Knowledge

- Displacement: 6,670 tonnes
- Equipped with supersonic surface-to-surface missiles
- Features MRSAM (Medium Range Surface-to-Air Missiles)
- Includes advanced anti-submarine warfare systems and SONAR
- Uses CODOG (Combined Diesel or Gas) propulsion system

Q10. Which of the following state police forces were awarded the President's Police Colour in 2026?

Solution

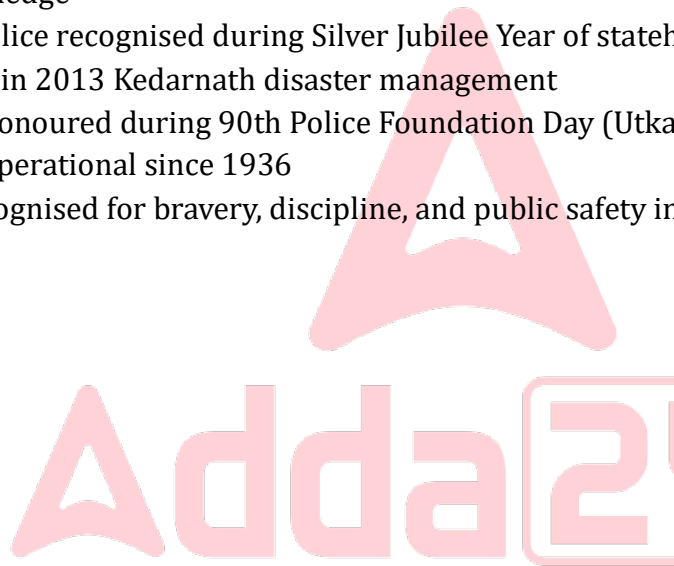
- The President's Police Colour was awarded to Uttarakhand Police and Odisha Police

- Award approved by Droupadi Murmu
- Uttarakhand Police honoured on 2 April 2026
- Odisha Police honoured on 30 March 2026
- Recognises service, professionalism, and internal security contribution

Additional Knowledge

- Uttarakhand Police recognised during Silver Jubilee Year of statehood
- Known for role in 2013 Kedarnath disaster management
- Odisha Police honoured during 90th Police Foundation Day (Utkal Divas)
- Odisha Police operational since 1936
- Both forces recognised for bravery, discipline, and public safety initiatives
