## Daily Current Affairs Quiz 9 April 2026

**Q1.** Who became the first fast bowler in the history of the Indian Premier League (IPL) to reach the milestone of 200 wickets?

- (a) Lasith Malinga
- (b) Jasprit Bumrah
- (c) Bhuvneshwar Kumar

**Ans.(c)**

**Sol.** The correct answer is (c) Bhuvneshwar Kumar

Explanation:

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar scripted history on April 6, 2026, by becoming the first fast bowler ever to claim 200 wickets in the Indian Premier League (IPL).
- He achieved this monumental feat during a high-profile clash between Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) and Chennai Super Kings (CSK).
- The milestone wicket was recorded when he dismissed CSK's young batter Ayush Mhatre, solidifying his legacy as one of the greatest pace bowlers in T20 history.
- While the top of the wicket-taking charts has traditionally been dominated by spinners like Yuzvendra Chahal, Bhuvneshwar's achievement marks a significant breakthrough for pace bowling in the league.
- His journey to 200 wickets is a testament to his longevity, swing-bowling masterclass, and death-over precision across 15+ seasons of the IPL.

Information Booster:

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar is currently positioned as the second-highest wicket-taker in IPL history, trailing only the leg-spinner Yuzvendra Chahal.
- He is the only bowler in the history of the IPL to win the Purple Cap in two consecutive years (2016 and 2017).
- In the 2016 season, he took 23 wickets helping Sunrisers Hyderabad win their maiden title, and in 2017, he improved his tally to 26 wickets.

Additional Knowledge:

- Lasith Malinga (Option a): The legendary Sri Lankan pacer was the long-time record holder for most wickets and the first to reach the 150-wicket and 170-wicket marks, finishing his IPL career with 170 wickets.
- Jasprit Bumrah (Option b): A premier fast bowler for Mumbai Indians, known for his yorkers; while he has a high wicket count, he has not yet crossed the 200-wicket threshold as of early 2026.
- Dwayne Bravo (Option d): A former CSK legend and the first player in IPL history to reach 180 wickets; he held the record for most wickets before being overtaken by Yuzvendra Chahal.

Explanation:

- The historic milestone of 200 IPL wickets by a fast bowler was reached during the 2026 season in a match between RCB and CSK.
- Bhuvneshwar Kumar, representing Royal Challengers Bengaluru, took the wicket of Ayush Mhatre to reach the "Double Century" of wickets.
- The event was widely celebrated as it occurred in one of the most-watched rivalries in franchise cricket, often termed the "Southern Derby" or the "El Clasico" of the IPL.
- Bhuvneshwar's performance in this match highlighted his continued relevance and effectiveness even after a decade in the league.
- This match further cemented his transition into the RCB camp, having previously spent a significant and successful decade with Sunrisers Hyderabad.

Information Booster:

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar made his IPL debut in 2011 and has represented multiple franchises including Pune Warriors India, Sunrisers Hyderabad, and Royal Challengers Bengaluru.
- His ability to bowl effectively in both the Powerplay (swing) and the Death Overs (knuckleballs/yorkers) makes him a rare versatile asset in the T20 format.

Additional Knowledge:

- Sunrisers Hyderabad (Option a): The team where Bhuvneshwar spent the majority of his career (2014–2024) and won his two Purple Caps.
- Punjab Kings (Option c): Currently the home franchise of Yuzvendra Chahal, who leads the overall wicket-taking charts with 223 wickets.
- Kolkata Knight Riders (Option d): Represented by Sunil Narine, who is the third-highest wicket-taker in IPL history with 193 wickets.

**Q3.** Who is the only bowler in IPL history to have won the "Purple Cap" (highest wicket-taker) in two consecutive seasons?

**Sol.** The correct answer is (b) Bhuvneshwar Kumar

Explanation:

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar holds the unique distinction of being the only player to win the Purple Cap in back-to-back years.
- He achieved this feat in 2016 (23 wickets) and 2017 (26 wickets) while playing for Sunrisers Hyderabad.
- The Purple Cap is awarded annually to the leading wicket-taker of the IPL season; winning it consecutively is considered one of the hardest achievements due to the evolving nature of T20 batting.
- His 2017 tally of 26 wickets remains one of the highest individual seasonal performances for a fast bowler in the league's history.
- This consistency over those two years was a primary reason for his rise as India's premier T20 specialist during that era.

**Information Booster:**

- In 2016, his wickets were instrumental in David Warner-led SRH winning their first and only IPL title by defeating RCB in the final.
- The 200th wicket milestone in 2026 further validates the longevity that allowed him to maintain such high standards for over 15 years.

**Additional Knowledge:**

- Harshal Patel (Option a): Won the Purple Cap in 2021 with 32 wickets (joint-most in a season) and again in 2024, but these were not in consecutive years.
- Kagiso Rabada (Option c): A South African pacer who won the Purple Cap in 2020 with 30 wickets for Delhi Capitals.
- Mohammed Shami (Option d): An Indian pace spearhead who won the Purple Cap in the 2023 season with 28 wickets.

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar occupies the second spot with 202 wickets, making him the highest-ranked fast bowler on the list.
- Sunil Narine (Kolkata Knight Riders) follows in the third position with 193 wickets, known for his mystery spin and economy.
- The list is heavily dominated by spinners, which makes Bhuvneshwar's presence in the Top 2 as a pacer even more remarkable.
- This ranking reflects the shift in IPL history where consistent wicket-takers like Chahal and Bhuvneshwar have surpassed earlier legends like Lasith Malinga and Dwayne Bravo.

**Information Booster:**

- Piyush Chawla is currently in the 4th position with 192 wickets, just one behind Sunil Narine.
- Ravichandran Ashwin rounds off the Top 5 with 187 wickets.
- Four out of the top five wicket-takers are Indians, showcasing the domestic bowling strength in the league.

**Additional Knowledge:**

- Piyush Chawla (Option b & d): Has represented KKR, MI, and CSK; he was a key part of KKR's title-winning seasons.
- Ravichandran Ashwin (Option c): A veteran who has played for CSK, RR, and PBKS; he is known for his carrom ball and tactical intelligence.
- Amit Mishra: Though not in the current top 5, he was the first Indian to take three hat-tricks in the IPL.

- The wicket was a classic example of Bhuvneshwar's skill, proving that he can still outsmart the newer generation of batters with his experience.
- Reaching this milestone against a powerhouse like CSK added to the prestige of the achievement, as CSK is known for its deep batting lineup.
- This particular dismissal will be etched in IPL history as the moment the "200-Club" opened its doors to fast bowlers.

Information Booster:

- Bhuvneshwar Kumar's career strike rate and economy have remained among the best for Indian pacers, especially in the Powerplay phase.
- He is often called the "Swing King" for his ability to move the white ball both ways in the initial overs.

- Ruturaj Gaikwad (Option a): The captain/prolific opener for CSK and a former Orange Cap winner.
- Ravindra Jadeja (Option b): One of the greatest all-rounders in IPL history and a mainstay for CSK for over a decade.
- MS Dhoni (Option d): The legendary former captain of CSK; Bhuvneshwar has had several iconic battles with Dhoni in the death overs throughout the years.
