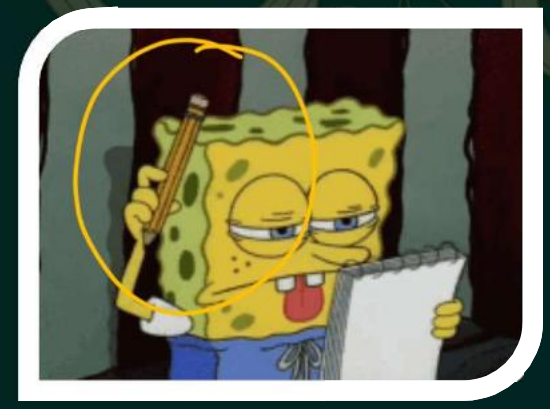
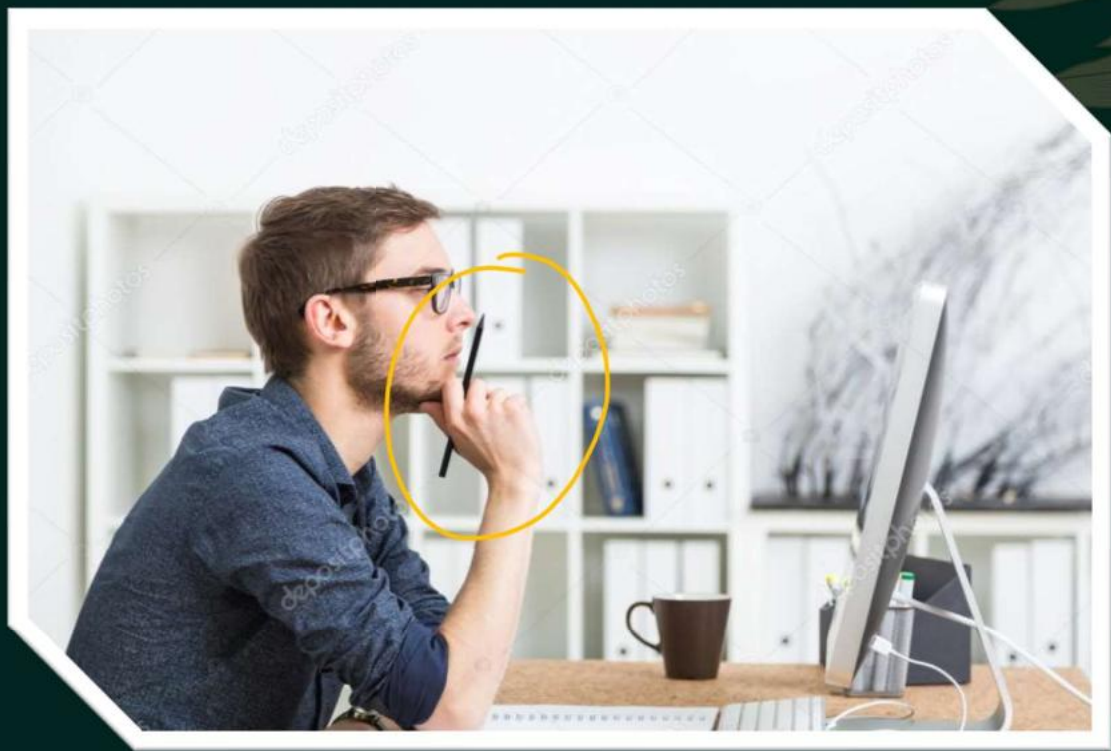

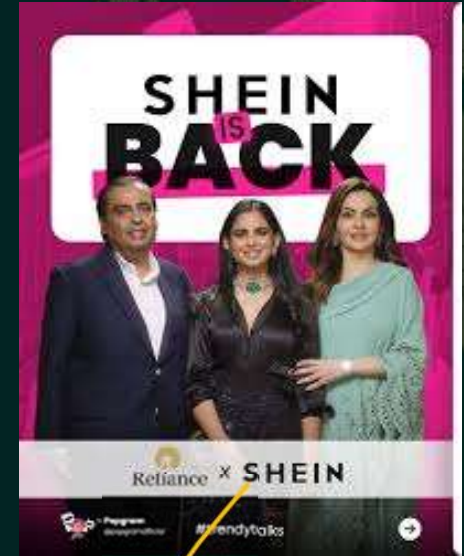

Acrid / Acute (sharp) Acetous
Acrimonious Enacerbate
Acerbic Acumen poor
(IQ) ↙

Acrid	Describes a sharp or biting smell or taste — physically harsh
Acrimony	Bitterness or sharpness in behavior or speech
Acerbic	A cutting or sour way of speaking — emotionally “sharp”
Acute	Sharp or intense (as in sharp pain or sharp angle)
Acumen	Sharpness of intellect or insight — mentally pointed
Acridness	The quality of being pungently sharp — irritating to senses
Exacerbate	To make something more bitter/sharper — worsen a harsh condition
Acetous	Tastes sour like vinegar — literally acidic or bitter
Acetate	Derived from acetic acid — carries the idea of chemical sharpness
Acetic	Relates to vinegar — sour/sharp in taste
Acid	Substances that are sour or burning/sharp to taste or touch
Acidity	Degree of being sour/sharp
Acuminate	Tapered to a sharp point — like a needle



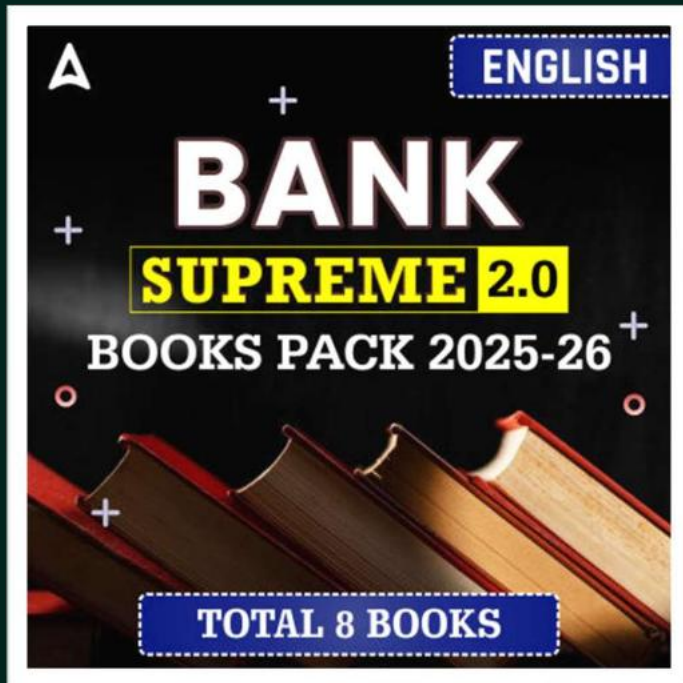

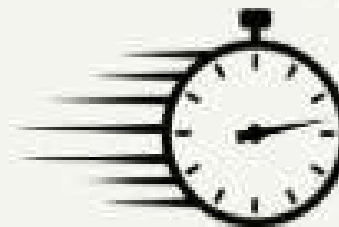
