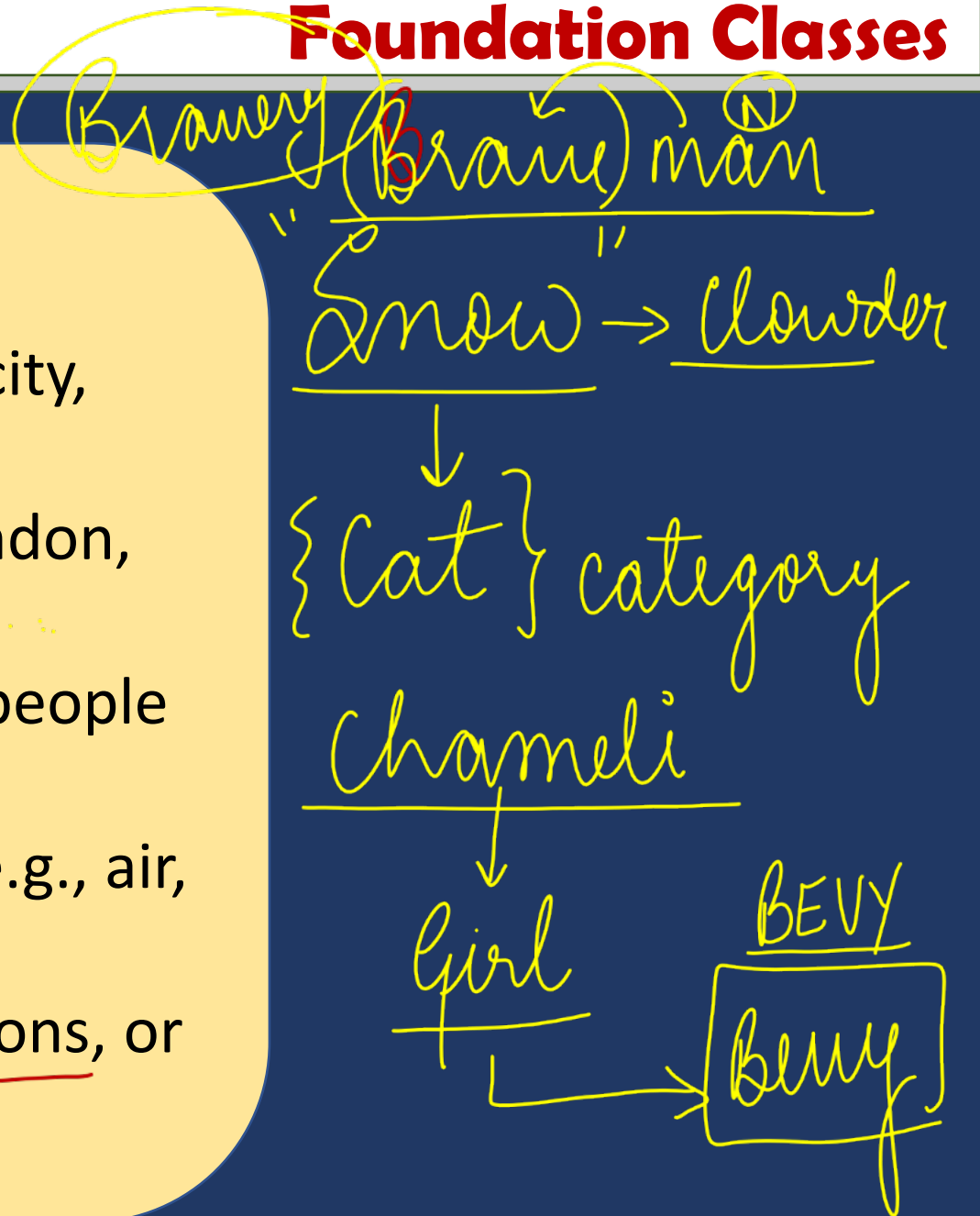


A **noun** is a word that names a **person, place, thing, or idea.**

Visible / Non-visible

Examples of Nouns:

- **Person:** Teacher, doctor, John, Mary
- **Place:** School, India, park, ocean ✓
- **Thing:** Book, table, computer, car
- **Idea:** Honesty, freedom, happiness, love



Types of Nouns:

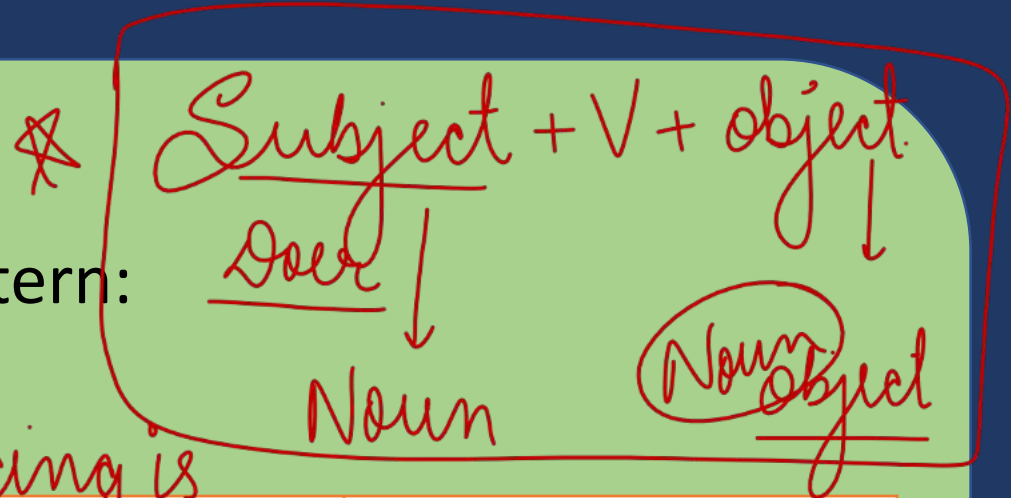
- 1. Common Noun** – General names (e.g., city, dog, river)
- 2. Proper Noun** – Specific names (e.g., London, Max, Amazon River)
- 3. Collective Noun** – A group of things or people (e.g., team, flock, audience)
- 4. Material Noun** – substance, element, (e.g., air, iron)
- 5. Abstract Noun** – Names of ideas, emotions, or qualities (e.g., bravery, justice)

- **Countable Noun** – Can be counted (e.g., apples, chairs)
- **Singular:** Apple, chair, book, car, bottle
- **Plural:** Apples, chairs, books, cars, bottles

- **Uncountable Noun** – Cannot be counted (e.g., water, air)
- **Substances:** Water, milk, sugar, salt, rice
- **Abstract Concepts:** Love, happiness, information, knowledge, advice

Suffix	Example Words	Meaning
-er / -or	Teacher, Actor, Doctor	A <u>person</u> who <u>does</u> something
-ist	Artist, Scientist, Pianist	A <u>person</u> skilled in something
-ian	Musician, Magician, Politician	A <u>person</u> <u>belonging</u> to a <u>field</u>
-tion / -sion	Information, Decision, Expansion	A <u>process</u> or <u>result</u>
-ment	Development, Achievement, Agreement	A state or action
-ness	Kindness, Darkness, Happiness	A quality or state
-ity / -ty	Ability, Responsibility, Creativity	A condition or quality
-ance / -ence	Importance, Patience, Confidence	A state or condition
-ship	Friendship, Leadership, Ownership	A <u>position</u> or <u>relationship</u>
-hood	Childhood, Adulthood, Brotherhood	A <u>period</u> or <u>state</u>
-ism	Criticism, Heroism, Tourism	A <u>belief</u> or <u>practice</u>
-age	Marriage, Courage, Breakage	An action or result
-y	Victory, Discovery, Jealousy	A condition or quality

To dance is my hobby.



Basic Sentence Structure

A sentence generally follows this pattern:

✓ Subject + Verb + Object (SVO)

She is dancing. / dancing is my hobby.

Component	Definition	Example
Subject (S)	Who or what the sentence is about	John reads a book.
Verb (V)	The action or state of being	John <u>reads</u> a book.
Object (O)	The person or thing affected by the action	John reads <u>a book.</u>

Check if the word names something

• If a word answers "Who?" or "What?", it is a noun.

✓ Examples:

- Who is coming to the party? → John
(Person)
- What is on the table? → Book (Thing)

→ Whom

Who / Whom / What

☆ a/an/the + **Noun**

Look for articles before the word

• **Articles (a, an, the)** usually come before nouns.

✓ **Examples:**

- **A** cat is sitting on **the** chair.
- She bought **an** umbrella.

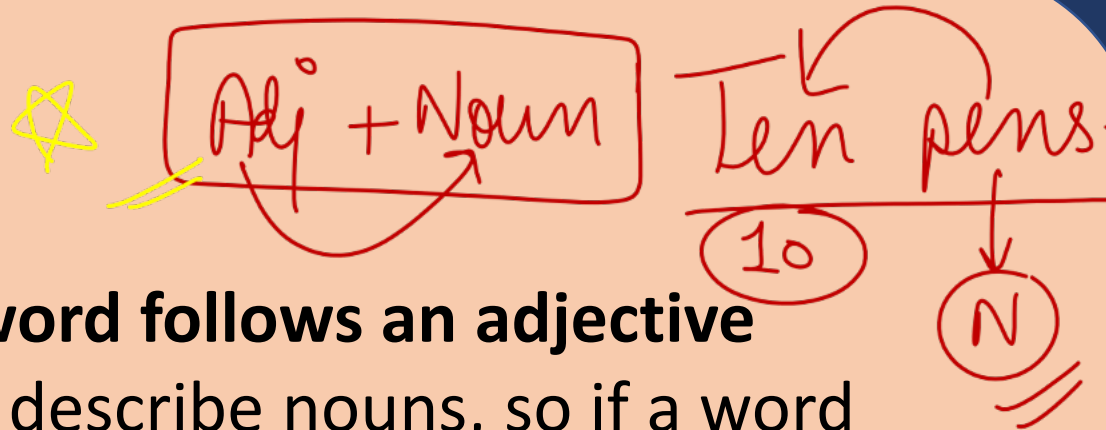

Check if the word has a plural form

• Most nouns can be made plural by adding -s or -es.

 **Examples:**

- **Book → Books**
- **Car → Cars**

See if the word follows an adjective

• Adjectives describe nouns, so if a word comes after an adjective, it is likely a noun.

✓ Examples:

- The **beautiful** garden. (Garden = Noun)
- She has a **big** house. (House = Noun)

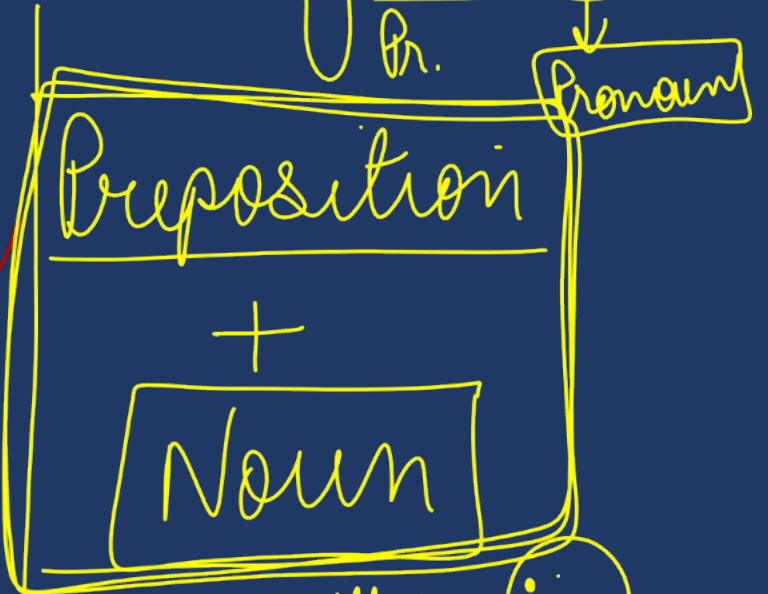
