1. Plural-Only Nouns with Two Parts

$N + (s/es) + V(Pl.)$

These nouns refer to objects made up of two connected parts, so they are always plural in form.

✓ Examples:

Scissors → ✂ (2) _{V(Pl.)}

My scissors are sharp

Trousers / Pants / Jeans / Shorts / Leggings (2) 

Her trousers are stylish.

Spectacles / Glasses / Goggles  (2)

His spectacles are missing.

Binoculars

◆ Clothing Items:

1. **Trousers** – My trousers are too tight.
2. **Jeans** – His jeans are faded.
3. **Pants** – These pants are comfortable.
4. **Shorts** – Her shorts are perfect for summer.
5. **Leggings** – My leggings are stretchy.
6. **Stockings** – Those stockings are made of silk.

◆ Accessories:

7. **Glasses** – My glasses are on the table.
8. **Spectacles** – His spectacles are broken.
9. **Goggles** – These goggles are necessary for swimming.
10. **Binoculars** – The binoculars are useful for birdwatching.
11. **Sunglasses** – Her sunglasses are too dark.

◆ Tools & Instruments:

12. Scissors – The scissors are very sharp.

13. Pliers – These pliers are useful for fixing wires.

14. Tweezers – My tweezers are in the drawer.

15. Forceps – The doctor's forceps are sterilized.

◆ Miscellaneous:

16. Tongs – These tongs are used for cooking.

17. Bellows – The bellows are kept in the fireplace.

18. Shears – The garden shears are heavy.

19. Clippers – Nail clippers are in the bathroom.

2. Plural-Only Nouns Referring to Groups

Some plural nouns represent a group or category and do **not** have a singular form.

✓ Examples:

Cattle

The cattle are grazing in the field.

People

People are waiting outside.

Police

The police have arrested the thief.

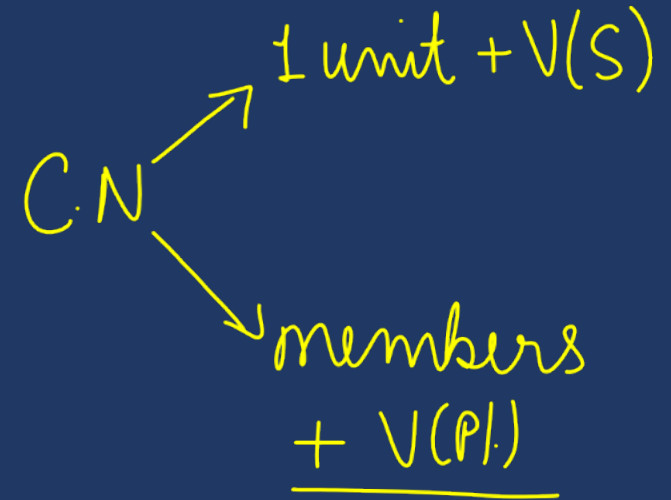

3. Collective nouns can be singular or plural

A **collective noun** (e.g., team, jury, audience) is singular when it acts as a unit but plural when referring to individuals.

✓ Examples:

- The team **is** playing well. (As a unit)
- The team **are** arguing among themselves. (As individuals)



Collective Noun	Singular Usage (Acts as <u>One Unit</u>)	Plural Usage (Acts as Individuals)
<u>Team</u>	The team is practicing for the final match.	The <u>team</u> <u>are</u> discussing their personal goals.
Committee ✓	The committee <u>has</u> approved the new policy.	The ^{members} committee <u>are</u> debating different ideas.
Family	My family <u>is</u> planning a vacation.	My ^{members} family <u>are</u> arguing over where to go.
Government	The government <u>is</u> introducing new laws.	The government <u>are</u> divided over the decision. ✓
Staff	The staff is working hard.	The staff are preparing reports individually.
Class	The class is listening to the teacher.	The class are talking among themselves.

4. Plural-Only Nouns for Games, Subjects, and Activities

Certain games and academic subjects are always plural in form.

✓ Examples:

• Billiards (Game)

- Billiards is my favorite sport.

• Darts (Game)

- Darts is played in pubs.

• Economics / Mathematics / Physics / Politics (Subjects)

- Mathematics is a difficult subject.
- Politics is always controversial.

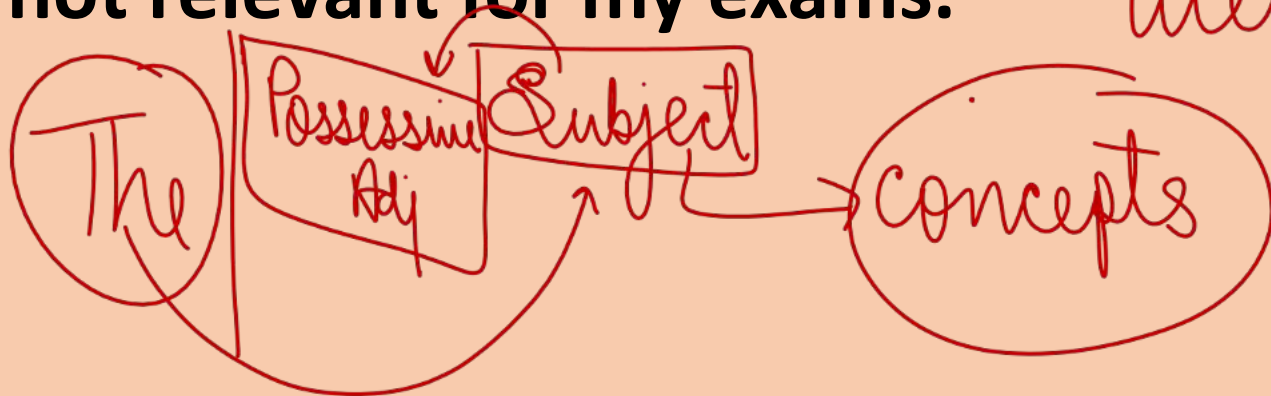

Uncountable nouns do not take an article (a/an) and have no plural form

- Incorrect: *She gave me ~~an~~ advice.* 
- Correct: **She gave me some advice.** 
- Incorrect: *He bought ~~a~~ furniture.* 
- Correct: **He bought some furniture.**

Force (Strength, power) – The force of the wind was strong.	Forces (Military, army) – The armed forces are well-trained.
Custom (Tradition, habit) – It is our custom to greet guests.	Customs (Border security) – The customs officers checked my bags.
Good (Kindness, virtue) – He always acts for the good of society.	Goods (Products, merchandise) – The store sells high-quality goods.
Iron (Metal) – Iron is used in construction.	Irons (Chains, handcuffs) – The prisoner was put in irons.
Glass (Material) – The window is made of glass.	Glasses (Eyewear) – He forgot his glasses at home.
Content (Meaning, information) – The book’s content is informative.	Contents (Items inside something) – The contents of the bag were checked.
Manner (Way of doing something) – He spoke in a polite manner.	Manners (Etiquette, behavior) – Good manners are important.
