Eight persons- A, B, C, D, E, F, G, and H sit around a circular table such that the distance between two adjacent persons is different. All of the persons face towards the centre. The distance between two adjacent persons varies in such a manner that the distance between two adjacent persons when counted in clockwise direction is 2m, 3m, 5m, 7m, 11m and so on. The circumference of the circular table is 77m.

The distance between H and D is 21m. A sits third to left of H. The distance between A and C is 12m. E sits immediate right of B. The distance between B and D is when counted from the left of B is more than the distance between C and D, when counted from the right of C. G doesn't sit 49m to the left of E.

A lives two floors above I, who lives on an even numbered floor. Only one person lives between I and E. As many persons live below E as above O. U lives two floors above O. M lives three floors below N. More than one person lives between M and R. Q doesn't live on a prime numbered floor.

Six persons Juhi, Asima, Yash, Ravi, Sunil, and Kusum work in school on six different designations among Director, Principal, Teacher, Librarian, Clerk, and Peon however not necessarily in the same order. The designations are in the same order of precedence such that the Director is the senior most designation and Peon is the junior most

designation. Each person uses different phones among Nokia, Apple, Samsung, Oppo, Vivo, and Motorola however not necessarily in the same order.

The one, who uses Motorola, is senior to Teacher. Only two persons have designation between Sunil and the one, who uses Motorola. The one, who uses Apple, is one designation junior to Sunil. Juhi is three designations senior to Ravi, who uses Nokia. The one, who uses Vivo, is junior to Ravi. Asima uses neither Apple nor Motorola. The one, who uses Oppo and Yash are senior to Asima.

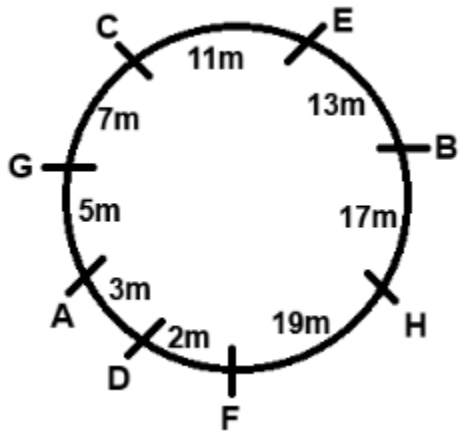
