Each person lives in different cities (Mumbai, Delhi, Pune, Kolkata, Nagpur and Varanasi). S, who lives in Pune, is three designations senior to T, who lives in Nagpur. Person, who lives in Delhi, is ADG. R is immediate senior to U, who lives in Varanasi. P is two designations senior to R. Person, who lives in Mumbai, is not junior to the person, who lives in Kolkata. P doesn't live in Mumbai.
