WORD & Syno.	Meaning	Example
1. Dissipate (v) • Disperse • Squander • Scatter • Accumulate (anto)	To disappear gradually, or to cause something to disappear gradually. / नष्ट करना या गायब हो जाना	Eg- The heat gradually <u>dissipates</u> into the atmosphere.
2. Appeal (n/v) • Plea • Request • Petition • Dissuade (anto)	A serious or urgent request, typically to the public. / अपील	Eg- The charity made an <u>appeal</u> for donations.
3. Belief (n) • Faith • Conviction • Trust • Doubt (anto)	An acceptance that something exists or is true, especially without proof. / विश्वास	Eg- His <u>belief</u> in honesty made him a trustworthy person.
4. Adequate (adj) • Sufficient • Enough • Ample • Insufficient (anto)	Satisfactory or acceptable in quality or quantity. / पर्याप्त	Eg- The resources were <u>adequate</u> for the project.
5. Secure (adj/v) • Safe • Protected • Guarded • Insecure (anto)	Fixed or fastened so as not to give way, become loose, or be lost. / सुरक्षित	Eg- He felt <u>secure</u> knowing his house was locked.
6. Defiance (n) • Resistance • Rebellion • Disobedience • Compliance (anto)	Open resistance; bold disobedience. / अवज्ञा	Eg- The <u>defiance</u> of the protesters was evident.
7. Efficiency (n) • Effectiveness • Productivity • Proficiency • Inefficiency (anto)	The state or quality of being efficient. / कार्यकुशलता	Eg- The <u>efficiency</u> of the new system saved time.
8. Commendable (adj) • Praiseworthy • Admirable • Laudable • Despicable (anto)	Deserving praise. / सराहनीय	Eg- Her efforts to help the poor were <u>commendable</u> .



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9. Demise (n) • Death • Passing • Decease • Birth (anto)	A person's death. / निधन	Eg- The sudden <u>demise</u> of the leader shocked everyone.
10. Deceptive (adj) • Misleading • False • Deceitful • Honest (anto)	Giving an appearance or impression different from the true one. / धोखादेह/मायावी/छलपूर्ण	Eg- His calm demeanour was <u>deceptive</u> .
11. Amaze (v) • Astonish • Astound • Surprise • Bore (anto)	To fill someone with wonder or astonishment. / चकित करना	Eg- The magician's tricks always <u>amaze</u> the audience.
12. Commute (v) • Travel • Journey • Shuttle • Remain (anto)	Travel some distance between one's home and place of work on a regular basis. / यात्रा करना	Eg- She <u>commutes</u> to work by train every day.
13. Breach (n/v) • Violation • Infringement • Break • Compliance (anto)	An act of breaking or failing to observe a law, agreement, or code of conduct. / उल्लंघन	Eg- The <u>breach</u> of contract led to a lawsuit.
14. Atrocity (n) • Outrage • Horror • Barbarity • Kindness (anto)	An extremely wicked or cruel act. / क्रूरता	Eg- The <u>atrocity</u> of the war crimes shocked the world.
15. Lethargy (n) • Sluggishness • Laziness • Inactivity • Energy (anto)	A lack of energy and enthusiasm. / सुस्ती	Eg- The heat induced a sense of <u>lethargy</u> in everyone.
16. Ramification (n) • Consequence • Result • Outcome • Cause (anto)	A consequence of an action or event, especially when complex or unwelcome. / परिणाम	Eg- The <u>ramifications</u> of the decision were far-reaching.
17. Arduous (adj) • Difficult • Strenuous • Laborious • Easy (anto)	Involving or requiring strenuous effort; difficult and tiring. / कठिन	Eg- Climbing the mountain was an <u>arduous</u> task.



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18. Fare (n) • Fee • Price • Charge • Free (anto)	The money paid for a journey on public transportation. / किराया	Eg- The bus <u>fare</u> has increased recently.
19. Impediment (n) • Obstacle • Hindrance • Barrier • Aid (anto)	A hindrance or obstruction in doing something. / बाधा	Eg- His speech <u>impediment</u> made communication difficult.
20. Saucy (adj) • Impudent • Cheeky • Sassy • Polite (anto)	Bold and lively; smart-looking. / नटखट	Eg- She gave him a <u>saucy</u> wink.
