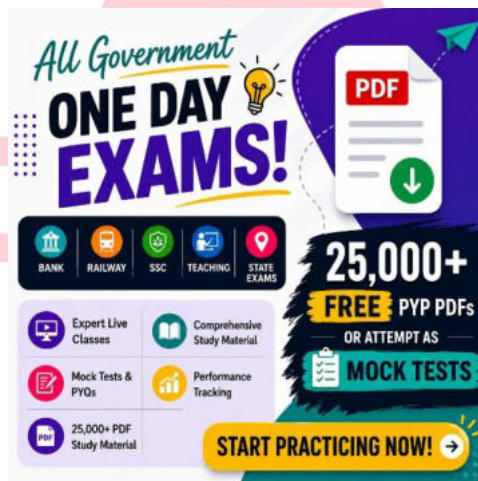

Q1. India received two Labbaytum Excellence Awards in 2026 from which country's Ministry of Hajj and Umrah?

Sol. Answer: (c) Saudi Arabia

Solution:

- India received two Labbaytum Excellence Awards in June 2026 for outstanding Haj coordination and communication.
- The awards were presented by the Ministry of Hajj and Umrah of Saudi Arabia during the closing ceremony of Haj 2026.
- The Indian Haj Mission was recognised for exemplary management of Haj operations and pilgrim services.
- This was the first time India received two Labbaytum Awards in a single Haj season.

Information Booster:

- The awards were presented during the Khitamahu Misk Ceremony in Makkah.
- Over 1.75 lakh Indian pilgrims participated in Haj 2026.
- India used the Haj Suvidha Application for digital travel and emergency services.

Solution:

- Jitendra Singh launched the AI-enabled voice chatbot "Samadhan Didi" in May 2026.
- The chatbot is associated with the Centralised Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS).
- It was developed by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) in partnership with BHASHINI.
- The chatbot allows citizens to register grievances through voice interaction in multiple Indian languages.

Information Booster:

- The chatbot supports all 22 languages listed in the 8th Schedule of the Constitution.
- It also supports regional languages such as Bhojpuri, Khasi, Mizo, Garo, and Bodhi.
- The AI system automatically categorises grievances and forwards them to the correct department.
- Citizens can file complaints simply by speaking in their preferred language.

Additional Knowledge:

- CPGRAMS stands for Centralised Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System.
- BHASHINI is India's AI-based language translation and speech technology initiative.
- DARPG functions under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions.

Solution:

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted a high-calibre conventional bomb trial in June 2026.
- The trial was carried out at the Terminal Ballistics Research Laboratory (TBRL) facility located at Ramgarh Range, Panchkula, Haryana.
- The test was conducted under standard operating procedures in the presence of senior Indian Air Force officials and DRDO scientists.
- The bomb was designed to function as a warhead for Indian Air Force missiles and other air-dropped munitions.

Information Booster:

- TBRL is a DRDO laboratory associated with explosive and ballistic research.
- The trial aimed to validate advanced munitions and defence capabilities.
- The Indian Air Force supervised the testing process along with DRDO scientists.
- The facility is located in Panchkula, Haryana.

- More than 1.05 crore collateral-free loans worth over Rs 17,800 crore have been sanctioned under the scheme.

- The scheme has benefited around 75.5 lakh street vendors across India.
- Over 2.59 lakh loans were distributed in the North-Eastern region.
- Manohar Lal Khattar and Tripura CM Manik Saha interacted with beneficiaries during the sixth anniversary event.

- Statement 3 is correct because Virat Kohli scored an unbeaten 75 runs off 42 balls.
- Statement 4 is correct since the IPL is organised by the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI).

- IPL 2026 was the 19th edition of the tournament.
- RCB received ₹20 crore prize money, while GT received ₹12.5 crore as runners-up.
- Virat Kohli became the first player to complete 9,000 IPL runs.
- Vaibhav Sooryavanshi won the Orange Cap and several other awards.

Solution:

- India signed a BrahMos missile export agreement worth around USD 629 million with Vietnam in May 2026.
- With this agreement, Vietnam became the second foreign buyer of the BrahMos missile system after the Philippines.
- The deal includes supply of missile systems along with training and logistical support.
- The announcement was made during the Shangri-La Dialogue security summit held in Singapore.

Information Booster:

- The Philippines was the first foreign buyer of BrahMos missiles in 2022.
- Indonesia is also in the final stages of negotiations for BrahMos procurement.
- The agreement strengthens India-Vietnam defence and strategic cooperation.

- The BrahMos missile is jointly developed by India and Russia.

- Citizens can upload photographs of issues such as garbage, stagnant water, drainage problems, and unclean public toilets for municipal action.

- The initiative aims to strengthen citizen participation in urban governance under the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM).

- The app was initially launched for 10 municipalities in West Bengal.
- The state plans to expand the app to 120 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs).
- The application contains more than 18 complaint categories.
- Complaints include garbage disposal, drainage issues, and dead animal removal.
