Q1. Which state launched India's first judiciary-integrated wildlife offence management system, 'HAWK', in June 2026?

Sol. Answer: (c) Kerala

Solution:

- Kerala launched the Hostile Activity Watch Kernel (HAWK) in June 2026.
- HAWK is India's first fully digitised and judiciary-integrated wildlife offence management system.
- The platform was introduced by the Kerala Forest Department to strengthen monitoring, investigation, and prosecution of wildlife crimes.
- It also helps combat Illegal Wildlife Trade (IWT) through better intelligence gathering and data management.

Information Booster:

- HAWK is a cloud-based Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system.
- It integrates wildlife offence records with the District Court Management System through an API.
- Kerala became the first Indian state to establish a judiciary-integrated wildlife offence management platform.
- The system was developed in collaboration with the Wildlife Trust of India (WTI) and NTT Data.

- The French Open is one of the four Grand Slam tennis tournaments.

- She defeated Maja Chwalińska 6–3, 6–2 in the final.
- The 2026 edition was the 125th French Open tournament.
- The event was organized by the French Tennis Federation (FFT).

- The initiative also included the inauguration of self-ticketing kiosks for easier ticket booking.

- It offers thematic tours such as Express Tour, Family Tour, Grand Zoo Tour, and My Tour.
- The self-ticketing kiosks support UPI-based digital payments.

- Its approach focuses on metabolic health through the science of millets and fermentation.

- The Rashtriya Ratna Samman recognizes excellence across India’s service sector.
- Award categories include technology, healthcare, education, pharmaceuticals, real estate, and business services.
- The event also witnessed the launch of the Bharat Innovations & Startups Facilitator (BISF) platform.

Solution:

- State Bank of India (SBI) Research, in its latest *Ecowrap* report, estimated India’s GDP growth at 7.7% for FY26.
- The report highlighted that stronger-than-expected economic performance in the fourth quarter (Q4 FY26) accelerated growth to 7.8%.
- Growth momentum was supported by strong services activity, robust industrial performance, rising private investment, and improved consumption trends.
- The report indicates continued resilience of the Indian economy despite global uncertainties.

Information Booster:

- The report projected India's nominal GDP growth at 12.5%–13% in FY27.
- Gross Value Added (GVA) increased by 7.9% in Q4 FY26 and averaged 7.9% for the full FY26.
- The services sector expanded by 9.9% in Q4 FY26.
- Total investment announcements reached a record Rs 80 lakh crore in FY26, with private investments accounting for Rs 56 lakh crore.

Additional Knowledge:

- GDP (Gross Domestic Product) measures the total value of goods and services produced in an economy.
- GVA (Gross Value Added) measures the contribution of different sectors to the economy.
- SBI is India's largest public sector bank.
- The manufacturing sector accounted for about 29% of new investment announcements in FY26.



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
