Q1. Which authority developed the Land Port Management System (LPMS) – VINIMAY launched by Union Minister Amit Shah in June 2026?

- It aims to modernize land port operations and facilitate cross-border trade and passenger movement.
- The platform enables real-time data sharing among multiple government agencies.
- It enhances operational efficiency, transparency, and border security.

- It cuts truck waiting time by 40–60% and gate processing time by 22–35%.

- It is expected to strengthen research, innovation, academic partnerships, and skill development.
- UNSW is one of Australia's leading research-intensive universities and a member of the Group of Eight (Go8).

- The initiative will reduce dependence on conventional grid power and generate long-term fiscal savings.

- The award recognized his contribution as a backup astronaut for the Axiom-4 mission associated with India's first mission to the International Space Station (ISS).
- The Kirti Chakra is India's second-highest peacetime gallantry award.

- Nearly 925 MW of clean energy capacity will support the facility, including power from CleanMax and Fourth Partner Energy.
- Desalinated seawater will be used for cooling the data centre infrastructure.

- The facility will be connected to Meta's global subsea cable network, Project Waterworth.
- RIL will provide end-to-end services including design, renewable power supply, connectivity, utility management, and operational support.
- The project builds upon Meta's USD 5.7 billion investment in Jio Platforms Limited in 2020, through which it acquired a 9.98% stake.
